


Thursday, May 1st & Friday May 2nd from 2:00 to 4:00 PM Saturday, May 3rd from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM

DID YOU KNOW? Short Mat Lawn Bowling is Growing in Popularity!

Short mat bowling is gaining momentum across Canada and beyond. This indoor version of lawn bowls, played on a compact carpet surface, continues to attract new players every year thanks to its accessibility, social atmosphere, and all-season play. With support from organizations like the Ontario Trillium Foundation, more clubs are forming, equipment is becoming more available, and participation is at an all-time high.

Here at our club, we've experienced remarkable growth and community engagement. Over the past year, we recorded more than **1,500 visits**, with over **10 bowlers playing more than 50 times**. We had **65 different members** participate in short mat and welcomed more than **40 additional guests** through our tournaments. It's clear that more people are discovering how fun and rewarding this version of the game can be.

Whether you're new to the sport or a seasoned lawn bowler, short mat offers a great way to stay active, social, and connected throughout the off-season. We encourage all of our summer bowlers to keep the momentum going by joining us indoors once the greens close. With no rain delays, no bugs, and plenty of laughs, it's a relaxed and welcoming way to stay in the game—and you just might discover your new favorite way to bowl.
